

T10 Smash - Cricket Tournament 2024

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

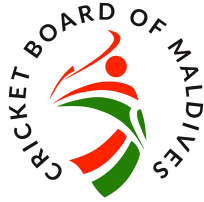
- ❖ Schedule date of the tournament – 15th Nov – 7th Dec 2024
- ❖ Team Participation notice deadline – 07th Nov 2024
- ❖ Draw date – 10th Nov 2024
- ❖ Final Date for the squad registration – 12th Nov 2024 15:00

THE FOLLOWING GENERAL GUIDELINES AND RULES SHALL APPLY

- Points shall be awarded in the Group Stage as follows:

Win Point	3
Draw (washout)	1 each
Loss	0

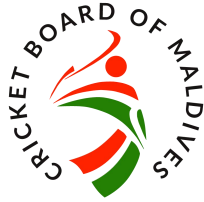
Super Over – if the scores are equal
- If more than two teams are equal end of the group stage. Following will apply.
 - a. The number of points teams have won at the group stage (team with the higher point / wins),
 - b. Net run rate
 - c. Head to head wins
 - d. Toss of coin
- A minimum of 9 players from each team are to be present 10 minutes before the scheduled match start time. The Toss is to be made 10 minutes prior to the scheduled match start time.
 - a A team that is not present at the specified times above shall be penalized at the conclusion of the tournament. The Team Manager and Captain will be referred to the C.B.M. Disciplinary Committee for a potential penalty. Penalties include fines not exceeding that of the individual match fees as well as suspensions on both the captain and the Manager.
 - b If a team does not show up for the match (a no show) then the team will be penalized with a fine of MVR 2,000. A penalty of MVR 5,000/- will be fined on the club for further repeated act of the same.
 - c Failure to meet the fines could result in the team getting barred from future CBM tournaments.
- Penalty on slow over rate and time wasting –
 - a up to 50% of the match fee money shall be deducted at the discretion of the Match Referee
 - b Repeated act (second time offence on another match) could result on the team captain being suspended for future match/matches of the tournament.



- c A total of 45 minutes is allocated for each innings. Failure to complete the innings within the time allocation will result in a penalty of 05 runs per over being awarded to the opposition playing team at the discretion of the Match referee.
- Registration of a Squad should be completed on the attached 'Squad Registration Form' along with written confirmation (by email to info@maldivescricket.org and copy to imad@maldivescricket.org) to confirm which Tournament(s) a Club wishes to participate in. A formal acknowledgment from C.B.M. Officials will be emailed upon accepting the Application.
- A maximum of 18 players can be named in a squad. Players' names can be added and removed from a squad in writing (by email to info@maldivescricket.org and copy to imad@maldivescricket.org) no later than 48 hours before the scheduled start of every match. A formal acknowledgment from C.B.M. Officials will be emailed when the Tournament Committee has accepted the change.
 - a However, a player pre-registered on another team for this T10 tournament (having played a match or not for that particular team) will not be accepted and allowed to change teams or get re registered to another team during the tournament.
 - b In proven emergency cases (supported by documents of proof) where a player is unable to take part in the rest of the tournament, he can be replaced 1 hour prior to the match.
- There will be no player ranking and distribution to any clubs from the current National Team 14 players.
- No restriction on foreign players. (players with valid work permits & Visas only)
- BV players has to play one league match.
- BV only 4 players can play at a time in a match no restriction on numbers of players to register.
- Tournament & Match Scoring will be undertaken by C.B.M. Officials & staff using Cricclubs software. Each club is welcome to take shared administration of their Club Page and Player List. Team and Individual statistics can be viewed and shared online and detailed Match Reports available. Live scoring of a match is available to view through a monthly subscription to Cricclubs.
- Playing Rules & Conditions will be taken from I.C.C. published 'T10 Match Playing Conditions' incorporating the 2023 Code of the MCC Laws of Cricket. Any changes to these rules will be specific to each tournament and communicated in advance of the scheduled start of a match and to each Club Official.
- An Umpires Report is expected to be completed at the end of each match. This Report is to be handed to the Match Referee no later than 1 hour after the end of a match.

Match Timings

- 10 overs per innings (Maximum 45 minutes to complete an innings)
- Innings break 10 minutes
- Each match - 100 minutes
- All matches to be played on Fridays and Saturdays



- Team has to report 30 minutes prior starting time.
 - Friday morning 07:30am – 9:30am (match 1)
 - Friday morning 09:40am - 11:40am (match 2)
 - Friday Afternoon 13:45pm – 15:45pm (match 1)
 - Friday Afternoon 15:55pm – 17:55pm (match 2)

 - **Saturday morning 08:30 – 10:30 and 10:30 – 12:30 (two matches)**
 - Saturday morning 08:30am – 10:30am (match 1)
 - Saturday morning 10:40am - 12:40am (match 2)
 - Saturday Afternoon 13:30pm – 15:30pm (match 1)
 - Saturday Afternoon 15:40pm – 17:40pm (match 2)

If any match finish early than the schedule time, next match will start in 10 minutes.

MOST RUNS SCORED MVR 500/-

MOST WICKETS MVR 500/-

MOST CATCHES MVR 500/-

Most Valuable Player MVR 1000/-

MATCH FEES (club incentive)

WINNING TEAM - MVR 600/- per match

LOOSING TEAM - MVR 400/- per match

Note: Ref. To CBM-Constitution, teams have to play all the matches in the tournament, for any reason, if a match is walkover by any team, that team will not be eligible as the tournament is completed.
